#### **MINUTES**

63<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Meeting Indian Geotechnical Society 1800 hrs, Thursday, the 16th December 2021 Online meeting on Zoom platform

#### ITEM 0 WELCOME BY THE PRESIDENT

Prof. N.K. Samadhiya, IGS President, welcomed the members to 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Meeting at the scheduled time. However, the meeting was adjourned for want of quorum and was reconvened after a break of two minutes.

Prof. N.K. Samadhiya, President, IGS thanked IGS-Trichy Chapter for making all necessary arrangements for the meeting.

The General Body was informed that many IGS members, namely, Prof. Gopal Ranjan, Prof. Bhawani Singh, Dr. V.M. Sharma, Prof. Narinder Puri, Prof. Anand Prakash, Prof. V. Bangereshwara Sarma, Dr. Biplab Kanti Som, Dr. Cyrus Tata, Mr. Jattinder Singh, Prof. D.K. Paul and Shri Sujit Das had passed away that year. The General Body observed a two minutes of silence as a mark of respect.

The President welcomed the Past Presidents of IGS, Members of Executive Committee and Members of IGS to 63<sup>rd</sup> AGM. Subsequently, the agenda items were taken up for discussion.

#### ITEM 1 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES

The Minutes of 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual General Meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020 online meeting on Zoom platform were circulated to the members as **Appendix-A** of the Agenda papers. No comments were received from the members. The General Body approved the minutes.



Some of these programs had the presence of experts from different countries also. A workshop on 4th March 2022, was organized by IGS Delhi Chapter in Collaboration with IGS SC 10 Committee, on Cone Penetration Test: Current Practices & Codes.

The Student Chapter Activities and Continuing Education Sub-committee (SC: 7) of IGS has organized a short course on "Pile Foundations" between 11th February and 5th March 2022 and a short course on 'Landslides' between 9th September and 24th September 2022. These short courses have covered related topics.

The IGS-Ferroco Terzaghi orations 2020 and 2022 were held at IIT Bombay on October 02, 2022. The seventh Oration was delivered by Prof. Jean Louis Briaud, U.S.A. on the topic "40 Years of Full-Scale Infrastructure Testing at a National Site" and the eighth by Prof. K.S. Rao, IIT Delhi on the topic "The Art of Tunnelling in Challenging Ground Conditions" respectively.

I am very happy to inform that our proposal to host the 12th International Symposium on Field Monitoring in Geomechanics in 2026 has been accepted and will be held at IIT Indore. I thank Prof Neelima Satyam and the team for the efforts and time.

The 20th ICSMGE under the banner of International Society for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering (ISSMGE) was held in hybrid mode during May 1-5th 2022 at International Convention Centre Sydney, Australia. More than 30 technical papers from various institutes and organizations across India were accepted for presentation. The Time Capsule Project, an initiative by ISSMGE was also launched on 3rd day of the conference. The Indian Geotechnical Society is also one of the contributory societies and till date, has submitted six

articles namely "Tunnels in the Himalaya" by R.K. Goel and Bhawani Singh, "Three decades of geosynthetics in India" by G. V. Rao, "Geological and Geotechnical aspects and challenges during construction of the Tehri Hydropower Project" by H.L. Arora, "Research work carried out in CSIR-Central Institute of Mining and Fuels Research, Dhanbad, India" by R.D. Dwivedi and R.K. Goel, "History of Teaching and Research on Geosynthetics at I.I.T. Madras" by K. Rajagopal and D.N. Arnepalli, and "Some Challenging Geotechnical Projects" by M.R. Madhav. To kick start the idea of SAASMGE (South Asian Association for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering) or SAAGS (South Asian Association of Geotechnical Societies), Kochi chapter has invited the office bearers of all South Asian Countries to participate in IGC 2022. The U.S. National Society for ISSMGE and Indian Geotechnical Society MoU and MoU on collaboration with ASCE India Section & IS Southern Region are in the process. We are looking forward for future collaboration programs with these Societies.

I would also like to inform you that from 2022, the first article in each issue of IGJ will be a "Feature Article" by Editors' Choice. This article will be an open access article freely available for download. Several professionals have contributed technical articles which have been published in IGS News since Jan-March issue of 2021.

The executive committee has approved new awards entitled IGS-Best Doctoral Thesis Award from Non-Premier Institutions sponsored by Prof. M.R. Madhav for the best thesis in Geotechnical Engineering which is open to all Indian Universities/ Institutions (non-premier), Best Teacher of Geotechnical Engineering Award, Award in Forensic Geotechnical Engineering and the awards for professionals as IGS-Award for Outstanding Contribution to Geotechnical Engineering Practice sponsored by M/s Geo Dynamics, Vadodara, IGS-Leadership award for Contribution to Geotechnical Engineering Practice sponsored by IGS Surat Chapter in memory of Dr. M.D. Desai, IGS-Gold Medal for the Best Geotechnical Engineering Practices on a Project sponsored by IGS Surat Chapter in memory of Dr. M.D. Desai and IGS-Young Professional Award for Geotechnical Engineering Practice sponsored by M/s Cengrs Geotechnica Pvt. Ltd., Noida.

We are looking forward to the Mega event of IGS, IGC 2022 at Kochi. Several interesting sessions have been planned by the organizers. The 9th Indian Young Geotechnical Engineers Conference 9YGEC-2023 shall be organized by Aurangabad Chapter during March 21-23, 2023.

The IGS elections for new executive committee for the term 2023-2024 were held successfully. Dr Anil Joseph and his team will take over the charge to steer ahead the activities of IGS. On behalf of the NEC 2021-2022, I wish him and his team a great success.
