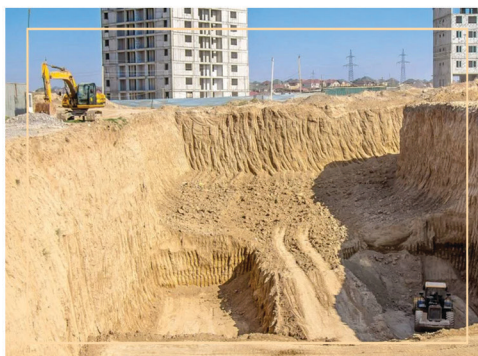

Historically, Karnataka housed some of the oldest chapters of IGS, which played a vital role in the 75 years growth of IGS. Three members from Karnataka had served as IGS presidents, seven members had delivered IGS annual lectures and also received the prestigious IGS Kuckleman awards and many have been serving in the National Executive Committee of IGS. The state has so far organized the Indian Geotechnical Conference (IGC) six times and the Asian Regional Conference (ARC) once. Currently the state houses four chapters of IGS, which are strategically located in Bangalore, Surathkal, Hubli and Mysuru. Karnataka Geotechnical Fusion (KGF) 2023 is a conference being jointly organized by all these chapters as a fitting tribute to the contributions of Karnataka in shaping up the IGS to its current stature and to fuse the IGS chapters of Karnataka into synergetic collaborations to wards solving important geotechnical problems of the state.
